

# STATUTORY DECLARATION

## Application for naturalisation Civil Partner of an Irish Citizen



### Important guidance to complete this Declaration

This statutory declaration must be completed by the civil partner who is applying for Irish citizenship through naturalisation based on their marriage to an Irish citizen.

**Failure to correctly complete and certify this declaration may result in the application being returned for correction and cause a delay in processing your application.**

### What you need



#### Completing the Statutory Declaration

The applicant is required to:

- Print the statutory declaration.
- Ensure that the Irish Citizens civil partner fills out the declaration accurately.
- Bring a form of photo ID along with this document to an Authorised Certifier.
- Confirm that the civil partner signs the declaration in the presence of the certifier.



#### What will the Authorised Certifier do

The Authorised Certifier will:

- Confirm your identity
- Ask your civil partner to sign the declaration in their presence
- Complete and sign the witness section of the form



#### Uploading the documents

You will need to:

- Scan the completed form
- Ensure that the completed document is clear and legible
- Log in to your online forms account and upload the document



#### Submission Checklist

Before uploading your document to the online application portal, check the following:

- The Authorised Certifier has confirmed your partners identity.
- The Authorised Certifier has certified that the declaration was signed by your civil partner in their presence.
- The Authorised Certifier has completed and signed the certification form.
- The document is clear and legible.
